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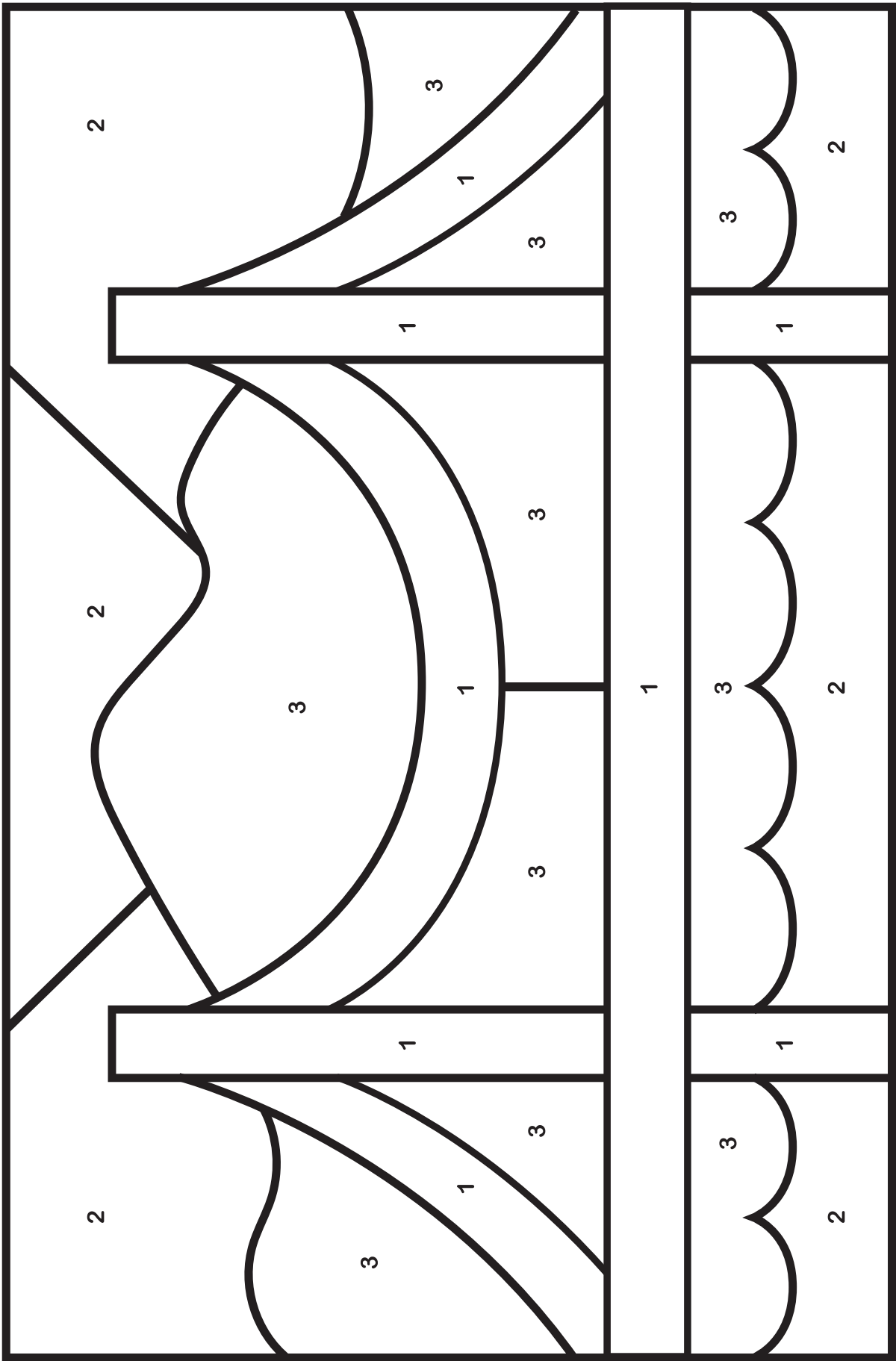

Color the bridge! 1 = brown 2 = blue 3 = green

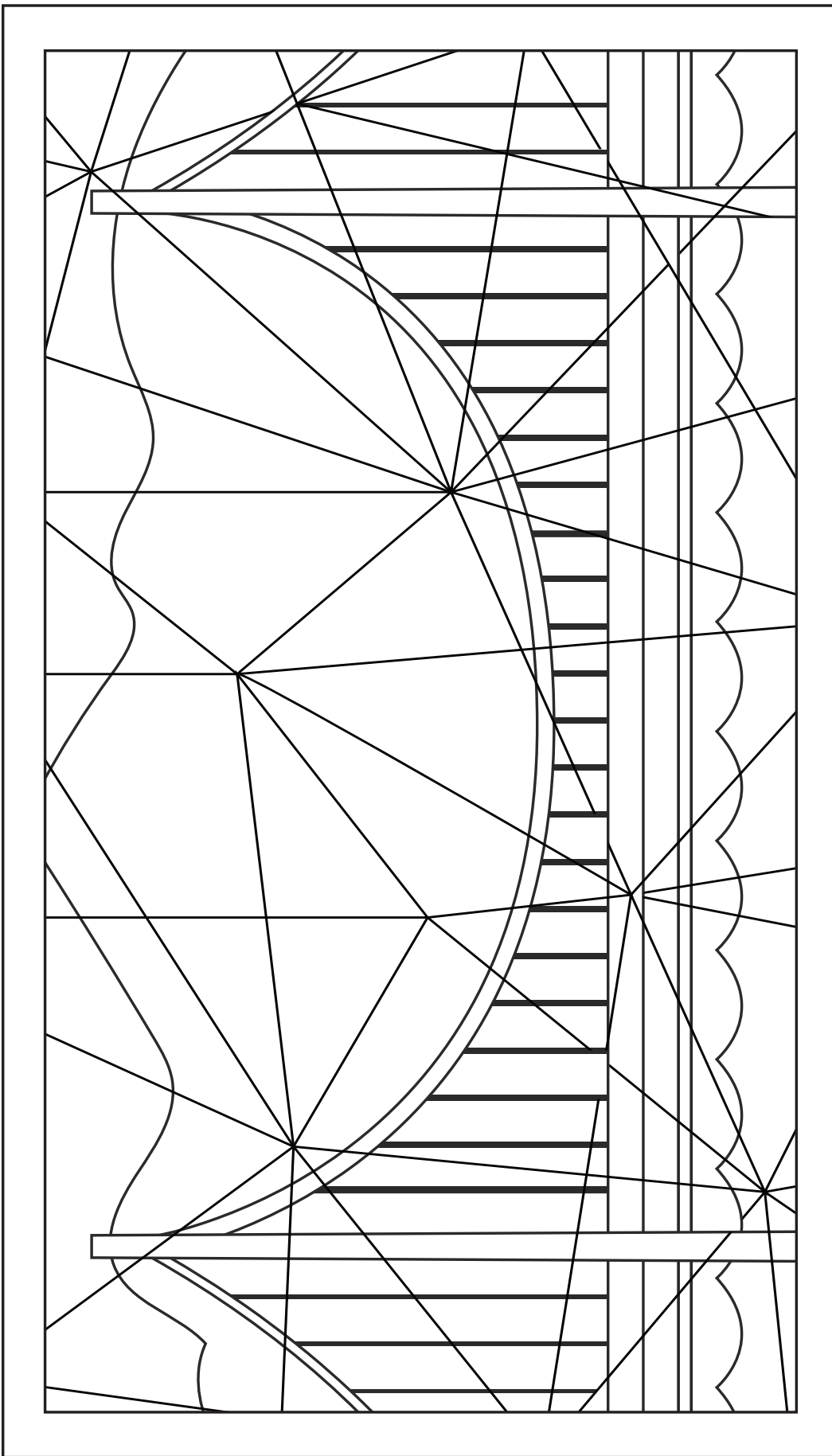
What to Do:
